Participants Arrive

Introduction

Assess each class members piece to be painted to see if requires additional preparation ie tannins, metal, laminate
Class members to wipe clean their piece

11.30 – 12.00

Class members paint first coat on piece

If you get everyone to paint first coat in white to get feel for brush strokes and also to give blank canvas to work from

12.00 – 12.30

Demonstration

Lime wash / Colour wash
2 Colour layering
Dark wax application

**It is important that before putting a second or third coat that the previous one is dry
If it is not dry you may need to put in the sun or use a hair dryer**

12.30 – 1.00

Class members paint a second coat on furniture piece

Discuss with them prior to putting next coat on the finish they want to achieve on the piece as this will determine whether or not they apply a third coat
